Prof. dr GA (Gerrit) van der Veen (1967) is Professor on Environmental law at the State University of Groningen, is lawyer and partner at AKD Lawyers and Civil notaries and heads AKD's Regulatory and Governmental Affairs Group in Rotterdam.

Gerrit specialises in administrative and environmental law, such as general administrative (procedural) law, public administration and private government action, environmental law/environmental liability, subsidy law and administrative compensation law.

Gerrit received his doctorate in 1997 from Utrecht University with a thesis entitled 'Openbare Zaken' (Public goods) on the confluence of public and private law, especially regarding public goods. Dutch magazines regularly publish his work and he has already annotated numerous rulings pronounced by the Supreme Court in the leading administrative journal for court cases (AB), particularly those concerning the distinction between public and private law, the judicial competence in matters regarding administrative cases, government liability and the division of jurisprudence.

Gerrit is also co-author of the book 'Systeem en algemene begrippen van de Algemene wet bestuursrecht' (System and General Concepts of General Administrative Law) and he is editor of Kennisbank Bestuursrecht, the SDU comments for administrative law, the real estate magazine (Vastgoedrecht) and the magazine for environmental law (TvO).
